**Completed applications must either be emailed or postmarked by June 14, 2024.**

*Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.* All completed and timely applications will be reviewed by the scholarship committee. The following criteria must be met: (1) enrolled citizen of the Upper Mattaponi Indian Tribe, (2) graduate or are graduating from High School, high school equivalency diploma, or another accredited Institution, and (3) acceptance into an accredited Community College, University, Trade school, apprentice program, or approved institution for preparation and testing for high school equivalency diploma. If you were awarded a scholarship from the Sharon Indian School Foundation, we will require your most recent transcripts to prove GPA of 2.0 or higher.

The amount of funds awarded will be announced in July via email following the committee's decision. Funds will be dispersed directly to the institution of the applicant's choosing. A special accommodation can be requested for students who may need to use the funds for something other than tuition assistance after the awards are announced.
